Vijayan rejects charges of police laxity in tribal man's murder case
THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan on Tuesday rejected in the Assembly allegations of the Congress-led UDF that there has been laxity on the part of the police and prosecution in the case of killing of a tribal man in Palakkad district in 2018. Vijayan told the Assembly that on noticing witnesses in the case turning hostile, the prosecution moved to cancel the bail granted to the accused. Besides that, a committee constituted in the district under the Witness Protection Scheme also held a meeting and decided to take stringent measures to ensure the witnesses are not intimidated or influenced by the accused in the case, he said.

TRS govt takes action against two vociferous BJP leaders
HYDERABAD: The Telangana government led by Chief Minister K Chandrashekar Rao on Tuesday cracked down on two important BJP leaders of the state -- party president Bandi Sanjay Kumar and Assembly Floor Leader T Raja Singh -- for different reasons and in separate places. Raja Singh was arrested for his alleged derogatory remarks on Islam and Prophet Mohammad while Sanjay Kumar was picked up by the police during his 'padayatra' and shifted to his residence in Karimnagar. Singh was arrested for his alleged remarks made in a video which was later pulled down by the social media platform on which it was uploaded. Following an uproar against his remarks, BJP suspended Singh from the party.

HC allows CCI to continue proceedings against Intel
BENGALURU: The High Court of Karnataka on Tuesday allowed the Competition Commission of India (CCI) to continue its proceedings against Intel Technology India Pvt Limited's India-specific warranty policy. The HC also imposed a cost of Rs ten lakh on the company for "delaying tactics". The petition challenging the competition watchdog's investigation into the India-specific warranty policy of Intel was pending since 2019. Earlier this year, a Supreme Court direction to dispose of the matter expeditiously and a timeframe set for it expired. Matrix Info systems, a New Delhi-based company, had filed a case before the CCI against Intel following which the CCI ordered an investigation whether the India-specific warranty policy of Intel was leading to denial of business to other importers of Intel's boxed Microprocessors into India.

TN govt has released glossary on addressing LGBTQ persons'
CHENNAI: The Tamil Nadu government has issued a glossary, as suggested by the Madras High Court, as to how the persons belonging to the third gender should be addressed/described. The Additional Advocate-General told Justice N Ananth Venkatesh on Tuesday that the glossary was published in the Tamil Nadu government gazette of the Social Welfare and Women Empowerment department on August 20 this year. He also furnished a copy of the same to the judge and submitted that by virtue of the publication of the glossary in the official gazette, the terms mentioned in it would have a statutory backing and whenever the LGBTQIA+ community is to be addressed by any forum, it is mandatory to describe them only by using the terms that have been mentioned in the gazette.

Two Bangla nationals held for staying without visa
ERODE (TN): The Perundurai police arrested two Bangladeshi nationals for staying here without visa. Based on information, the police raided a premises at Panikkampalayam on Monday, where they found two persons identified as Samsujaman Sardar (39) and Allaudin Gazi (33) staying without proper permit. The two when inquired admitted that they are working in a private firm for the past one-year without any visa. The police arrested them and registered a case under section 3 (2) (c) read with 14 of the Foreigners Act and 3 (3) Passport (entry to India) Act. The Bangladeshi nationals passports were seized by the police. They were later taken to Puzal prison in Chennai and were remanded there, police said.

15-year-old road mishap victim saves six lives with her organs

A 15-year-old girl, who met with a fatal road accident on August 15, saved with her organs the lives of six people, including a woman from Bihar's Bhagalpur who received her heart. The heart transplant on the 32-year-old woman, with terminal heart failure following childbirth, was conducted at the Atal Bihari Vajpayee Institute of Medical Sciences, Dr RML Hospital, here on Monday. Laxmi Devi was suffering from breathlessness severe enough to curtail even routine daily activities, the hospital said in a statement. She was evaluated at the RML Hospital by a team of cardiologists who advised a heart transplant, following which she was registered with the National Organ and Tissue Transplant Organisation (NOTTO), the statement



According to the statement, the donor girl, Basu, had met with an accident on August 15 and was admitted to the PGIMER in Chandigarh with severe head injury. She was declared brain dead on August 20 and was kept on a ventilator to sustain her organs, the statement

"For how long will the prime minister continue to save tainted ministers? For how long will you continue to encourage this language of abuse?" she said in a tweet in Hindi.

'FOR HOW LONG WILL PM CONTINUE TO SAVE TAINTED MINISTERS'

In a video apparently of a speech made to his supporters, Mishra dismissed allegations levelled against him. Slamming Mishra for his remarks, Congress general secretary Priyanka Gandhi said, "Look at the effect of the intoxication of protection of power. The Minister of State for Home Affairs is making one statement after another degrading the farmers. He had threatened the farmers even before the Lakhimpur farmers' massacre." "For how long will the prime minister continue to save tainted ministers? For how long will you continue to encourage this language of abuse?" she said in a tweet in Hindi.

people, including four farmers and a journalist, were killed in the violence at Tikunia village here during a farmer protest against the visit of UP Deputy Chief Minister Keshav Prasad Maurya to Mishra's village in Lakhimpur Kheri district. In

this case, Mishra's son Ashish Mishra has been arrested as the main accused.

"People keep raising questions. There are also 'bakooof patrakar' (stupid journalists) who have no relationship with journalism and want to create confusion by

such 'ulti-seedhi baat' (unfounded things)," he said.

"I know Rakesh Tikait very well, he is a 'do kaudi ka aadmi' (second rate person). He fought election twice and lost the deposit. If this kind of a man opposes anyone, it is of no value and so I do not answer to such people as it is of no relevance," Mishra said.

Led by Tikait, the Samyukt Kisan Morcha (SKM) had staged a 75-hour long dharna in Lakhimpur last week to press for various demands, including sacking of Mishra. "He (Tikait) is doing politics in this manner and running his livelihood. They will be given a reply at the right time," Mishra is heard telling BJP workers in the video apparently in his Kheri constituency. Reacting to Mishra's comments, Tikait said it was natural for him to be angry when his son is in jail for the past one year.

Yediyurappa flags off Savarkar Rath Yatra in Mysuru

MYSURU: Karnataka BJP strongman B S Yediyurappa on Tuesday flagged off the 'Savarkar Rath Yatra' here, aimed at informing people about V D Savarkar and the principles and values propounded by him. The former Chief Minister also hit out at Leader of Opposition in the State Assembly Siddaramaiah, a known critic of Savarkar, for his repeated remarks attacking the Hindutva icon.

Mysuru is the home district of Siddaramaiah. "Through Savarkar Rath Yatra, we want to create awareness among people about Savarkar, his ideology, his sacrifices for the country and principles. It is to awaken patriotic feelings among people," Yediyurappa said. Speaking at the event, he said, disinformation campaign is on against Savarakar and called on people to take his message to "every house and mind".

"Savarakar was a great freedom fighter. Former Prime Minister Indira Gandhi had addressed him as Veeer, but the disinformation campaign that is going on against him in Karnataka has painted me," he said, adding that it is an "unpardonable crime" to cause disrepute to a revolutionary leader like Savarkar for



"petty politics".

Later speaking to reporters, Yediyurappa said it is not right on the part of Siddaramaiah and the post he holds to speak lightly about Savarkar, without knowing facts.

"The person who does not have an idea of religion, nation, is speaking irresponsibly forgetting that he is the leader of opposition and a former Chief Minister. It is not befitting to the position he holds. If he continues to speak like this people will teach him a lesson and that time is not too far away," he said. The rath yatra, organised by Savarkar Foundation was launched by Yediyurappa on the premises of Sri Kote Anjaneya Swamy Temple, near the Mysuru Palace here. The yatra will tour Mysuru, Mandya and Chamara Nagar districts till August 30, the organisers said.

School detains students in classroom over 'unpaid' fees

BHUBANESWAR: Dozens of students of a private school in Bhubaneswar were allegedly confined in a room by teachers, who claimed that the fees were not paid by the kids' guardians. Irrate parents of several children staged a sit-in in front of the school's gate at Ghatikia on Tuesday, demanding strict action against the teachers for the harassment.

As many as 34 students were kept in a room for around five hours on Monday and were not allowed to eat, drink or go to the toilet, their parents told reporters. The teachers rejected the kids' request to make phone calls to their parents, informing them that they were confined as their tuition fees were not deposited on time. The school authorities then gave a notice to the students, asking them to give it to their guardians. One of the parents claimed that they had already paid tuition fees online, but it was not showing in the record due to a technical issue. A school spokesperson refused to comment on the issue.

17 cattle seized from truck in Aurangabad

AURANGABAD: The police seized 17 cattle, including cows, which were being transported illegally in a truck in Maharashtra's Aurangabad district, police said on Tuesday. The police intercepted the truck on Waluj-Aurangabad road on Monday night and found seven bullocks and 10 cows being transported illegally, an official said. Three men who were transporting the cattle alighted from the vehicle and managed to flee, he said. An offence under the Prevention of Cruelty to Animals Act 1960 and Maharashtra Animal Preservation (Amendment) Act 1995 has been registered, the official said.

SC orders shifting of conman Suresh Chandrashekhar from Tihar to Mandoli prison

NEW DELHI

The Supreme Court on Tuesday ordered that alleged 'conman' Suresh Chandrashekhar and his wife be shifted from Tihar jail to Mandoli jail in the city. A bench of Justices S R Bhat and Sudhanshu Dhulia passed the order on a plea filed by Chandrashekhar and his wife alleging a threat to their lives and seeking a transfer to a prison outside Delhi.

Chandrashekhar is lodged in jail on charges of alleged money laundering and duping several people. "Having considered the materials on the record and also having regard to the order made on June 17, 2022, this court is of the opinion that in terms of the statement made by the respondent on June 23, 2022, the petitioners should be shifted to Mandoli jail. It is accordingly ordered," the bench said, adding they be shifted to the Mandoli

jail within a week.

"This is an order for both," the bench said orally. Additional Solicitor General (ASG) S V Raju argued before the bench that Chandrashekhar is running a "extortion racket" and a "conning racket" from inside the Tihar Jail and several prison officials have been suspended.

He said Tihar Jail has become difficult for him to operate so he wants to be shifted to another prison so that he can start his racket again. Senior advocate R Basant, appearing for Chandrashekhar and his wife, said they are lodged in Tihar jail and they have been treated "very unfairly" there.

He said Chandrashekhar's grievance is against high-ranking police officials and money was extorted from him for providing him security. "The point is where is your right? Where is the perceptible threat?" the bench observed.

Vijayan rejects charges of police laxity in tribal man's murder case

THIRUVANANTHAPURAM: Kerala Chief Minister Pinarayi Vijayan on Tuesday rejected in the Assembly allegations of the Congress-led UDF that there has been laxity on the part of the police and prosecution in the case of killing of a tribal man in Palakkad district in 2018. Vijayan told the Assembly that on noticing witnesses in the case turning hostile, the prosecution moved to cancel the bail granted to the accused. Besides that, a committee constituted in the district under the Witness Protection Scheme also held a meeting and decided to take stringent measures to ensure the witnesses are not intimidated or influenced by the accused in the case, he said.

TRS govt takes action against two vociferous BJP leaders

HYDERABAD: The Telangana government led by Chief Minister K Chandrashekar Rao on Tuesday cracked down on two important BJP leaders of the state -- party president Bandi Sanjay Kumar and Assembly Floor Leader T Raja Singh -- for different reasons and in separate places. Raja Singh was arrested for his alleged derogatory remarks on Islam and Prophet Mohammad while Sanjay Kumar was picked up by the police during his 'padayatra' and shifted to his residence in Karimnagar. Singh was arrested for his alleged remarks made in a video which was later pulled down by the social media platform on which it was uploaded. Following an uproar against his remarks, BJP suspended Singh from the party.

HC allows CCI to continue proceedings against Intel

BENGALURU: The High Court of Karnataka on Tuesday allowed the Competition Commission of India (CCI) to continue its proceedings against Intel Technology India Pvt Limited's India-specific warranty policy. The HC also imposed a cost of Rs ten lakh on the company for "delaying tactics". The petition challenging the competition watchdog's investigation into the India-specific warranty policy of Intel was pending since 2019. Earlier this year, a Supreme Court direction to dispose of the matter expeditiously and a timeframe set for it expired. Matrix Info Systems, a New Delhi-based company, had filed a case before the CCI against Intel following which the CCI ordered an investigation whether the India-specific warranty policy of Intel was leading to denial of business to other importers of Intel's Boxed Microprocessors into India.

TN govt has released glossary on addressing LGBTQ persons

CHENNAI: The Tamil Nadu government has issued a glossary, as suggested by the Madras High Court, as to how the persons belonging to the third gender should be addressed/described. The Additional Advocate-General told Justice N Ananth Venkatesh on Tuesday that the glossary was published in the Tamil Nadu government gazette of the Social Welfare and Women Empowerment department on August 20 this year. He also furnished a copy of the same to the judge and submitted that by virtue of the publication of the glossary in the official gazette, the terms mentioned in it would have a statutory backing and whenever the LGBTQIA+ community is to be addressed by any forum, it is mandatory to describe them only by using the terms that have been mentioned in the gazette.

Two Bangla nationals held for staying without visa

ERODE (TN): The Perundurai police arrested two Bangladeshi nationals for staying here without visa. Based on information, the police raided a premises at Panikkampalayam on Monday, where they found two persons identified as Samsujaman Sardar (39) and Allaudin Gazi (33) staying without proper permit. The two when inquired admitted that they are working in a private firm for the past one-year without any visa. The police arrested them and registered a case under section 3 (2) (c) read with 14 of the Foreigners Act and 3 (3) Passport (entry to India) Act. The Bangladeshi nationals passports were seized by the police. They were later taken to Puzal prison in Chennai and were remanded there, police said.

Moosewala's father takes fight for justice to social media

RAJESH MOUDGIL Chandigarh Two days after threatening to launch a protest if the Aam Aadmi Party government in Punjab failed to crack the singer Sidhu Moosewala's murder case in a week, his father Balkaur Singh on Tuesday created social media accounts seeking, what he termed as, "complete justice" for his son also demanding the arrest of people who provided money to the shooters and harboured them. His Twitter handle #JusticeforSidhuMoosewala read that a peaceful candle march

would be organised by Sidhu Moosewala's family to demand justice for him at Lakshmi Narayan Mandir, Purani Anaj Mandi, Mansa, at 4 pm on August 25. "I know Rakesh Tikait very well, he is a 'do kaudi ka aadmi' (second rate person). He fought election twice and lost the deposit. If this kind of a man opposes anyone, it is of no value and so I do not answer to such people as it is of no relevance," Mishra said.

Led by Tikait, the Samyukt Kisan Morcha (SKM) had staged a 75-hour long dharna in Lakhimpur last week to press for various demands, including sacking of Mishra. "He (Tikait) is doing politics in this manner and running his livelihood. They will be given a reply at the right time," Mishra is heard telling BJP workers in the video apparently in his Kheri constituency. Reacting to Mishra's comments, Tikait said it was natural for him to be angry when his son is in jail for the past one year.

BJP leader & Tik Tok star dies in Goa

Police lodge a case of unnatural death

BJP leader from Haryana and actor Sonali Phogat, who shot to fame as a Tik Tok star, died of a 'suspected' heart attack in Goa, police said on Tuesday.

Phogat, 42, was on a visit to Goa along with her staff. She was brought to St Anthony Hospital at Anjuna in North Goa district after she complained of uneasiness on Monday night at a restaurant there, Goa director general of police Jaspal Singh told PTI.

Singh said there is no foul play in the case, even as Phogat's family questioned the circumstances of her death and opposition demanded a CBI probe.

There are no external injury marks on the body, the DGP said, adding the postmortem report will reveal the exact cause.

Police have registered an unnatural death case, another senior police official said on Tuesday. "Preliminary inquiry has revealed that she had come to Goa on August 22 and was staying in a hotel in Anjuna. Today early morning she started feeling uneasiness at a hotel and was shifted to hospital wherein she was declared brought dead," deputy superintendent of police (Mapusa) Jivba Dalvi said, adding, "unnatural death" case was registered at Anjuna.

Her sister Raman told reporters in Hisar that Phogat called up her mother and told her about not feeling well after she had her food.

"She had said she was feeling uneasy. She sensed as if something was not right as if some conspiracy was being played against her. Later in the morning, we received the news that she was no more," she said, adding that Phogat did not suffer from any previous illness.



ACCIDENTAL FIRING OF BRAHMOS MISSILE INTO PAKISTAN

IAF sacks 3 officers

AGENCIES New Delhi

Three officers of the Indian Air Force were sacked on Tuesday for the March 9 accidental firing of a Brahmos missile that landed in Pakistan. A statement said the services of the officers were terminated after a Court of Inquiry (CoI) found that deviation from the standard operating procedures (SOP) by them led to the accidental firing of the missile. Following the incident, the defence ministry described it as "deeply regrettable" while Pakistan lodged a strong protest over it.

"A BrahMos missile was accidentally fired on March 9. A Court of Inquiry, set up to establish the facts of the case, including fixing responsibility for the incident, found that deviation from the standard operating procedures by three officers led to the accidental firing of the missile," the statement said. "The three officers have primarily been held responsible. Their services have been terminated by the central government with immediate effect. Termination orders have been served upon the officers on August 23," it said.

Though the IAF did not mention the ranks and names of the officials whose services have been terminated, it is learnt that a group captain is among the three.



All political parties are in favour of freebies: SC

NEW DELHI

All political parties including BJP are in favour of freebies and due to this a judicial attempt has been made to deal with it, said the Supreme Court on Tuesday while deliberating with a PIL opposing promises of such handouts by the parties during polls. The top court also rapped Dravida Munnetra Kazhagam (DMK) and some of its leaders for making statements on the issue of freebies and the judicial intervention on the ground that welfare measures are for uplifting marginalised people and cannot be held as "freebies".

"On this issue, I can say all political parties are on one side including BJP. Everybody wants freebies. That is the reason we made an attempt," a bench comprising Chief Justice N V Ramana and Justices Hima Kohli and C T Ravikumar observed during the hear-

ing. The intention was to initiate a "wider public debate" on the issue and for this purpose, the setting up of the committee was mooted, the bench said, adding "We have to see what is freebie and what is welfare."

"The bench said it has to balance the equity and it was not against any policy of the government or the scheme. "Some said, we have no right to entertain. No right to look into the issues...See, if tomorrow, somebody comes to us and says that we are not the beneficiaries of the scheme... Can we say no? We cannot deal with this. See, we have to balance it. We are not against any policy of the government. We are not against any schemes..." the bench said. During the hearing, as soon as senior advocate P Wilson commenced submitting on behalf of the DMK, the bench referred to some statements of party leaders and came down on them.

School detains students in classroom over 'unpaid' fees

BHUBANESWAR: Dozens of students of a private school in Bhubaneswar were allegedly confined in a room by teachers, who claimed that the fees were not paid by the kids' guardians. Irate parents of several children staged a sit-in in front of the school's gate at Ghatikia on Tuesday, demanding strict action against the teachers for the harassment.

As many as 34 students were kept in a room for around five hours on Monday and were not allowed to eat, drink or go to the toilet, their parents told reporters. The teachers rejected the kids' request to make phone calls to their parents, informing them that they were confined as their tuition fees were not deposited on time.

Kejriwal alleges 'Maha Vyapam scam' in Guj, promises 10-year jail if AAP comes to power

Delhi Chief Minister Arvind Kejriwal on Tuesday claimed a "Maha Vyapam scam" in the Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP)-ruled Gujarat where-in questioned papers of the state government recruitment examinations have been leaked over years. He promised a law against the paper leak with a provision of 10-year jail if the Aam Aadmi Party (AAP) is voted to power in the Assembly elections, due later this year.

"Did anybody go to jail for leaking papers? They will now go to jail (when AAP forms a government). Madhya Pradesh had the 'Vyapam scam. In Gujarat, a 'Maha Vyapam scam' is going on," Kejriwal alleged while addressing a town hall meeting of youth at Bhavnagar on the second day of his two-day visit to Gujarat.

The Vyapam scam was an entrance examination, admission and recruitment scam unearthed in Madhya Pradesh, also ruled by the BJP, in 2013. The scam is called "Vyapam" which is the Hindi acronym of the

Madhya Pradesh Professional Examination Board.

"They made the CBI conduct raids on Manish Sisodia (Delhi Deputy CM) based on a false case even when he did nothing wrong, but no CBI raid was conducted against those involved in leaking the (government exam) papers (in Gujarat). Why? Because people behind the paper leak are their own," the AAP national convener asked. Sisodia was also present at the event.

The Vyapam scam allegedly involved candidates and job aspirants, government officials, and some politicians wherein imposters wrote answer papers. The case was handed over to the Central Bureau of Investigation following a Supreme Court order in 2015. Kejriwal listed several cases of the paper leak that were reported in Gujarat since 2015 and asked whether the BJP government felt ashamed. "They can't conduct exams, how will they run the government?" he asked. The AAP leader promised stringent action against perpetrators if voted to power.



Wild elephant dies in Kerala

THRISSUR (KER): A wild elephant has died after allegedly falling into a septic tank in the backyard of an uninhabited house near a forest area in this district, forest officials said on Tuesday. A forest officer said the young tussock male elephant, which strayed into the area inhabited by humans by demolishing the solar fencing, was found dead with its face falling first into the septic tank. The incident was reported from Vellikulangara forest range. Officials said the elephant would be lifted from the area using a crane and it would be buried after the postmortem.
